
# The Meadow's Messenger July 2025 A Quail Meadows West Homeowners Association Publication

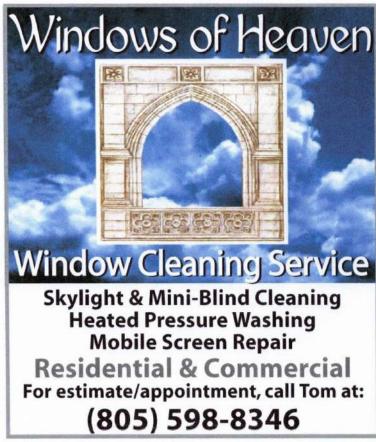

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
