Other issues to remember: Guest parking is for guests only and not for homeowners' or tenants' overflow. This has been discussed over and over but some just refuse to abide by the rules. With a two car garage and 2 driveway spots, no one should be parking in the street or at guest parking. We will be giving notice to all who refuse to follow the rules. After that we will be fining them \$50 per infraction. Homeowners & landlords, inform your tenants since YOU the homeowner will be responsible for the fine.

Architectural Committee: We have had some homeowners not following the Architectural Committee's notices and not completing projects. Once the committee sends you a request to repair or complete (typically 3 letters) if it is ignored you will be hearing from the HOA Board. If you still refuse to remedy the issue there will be a \$50 fine the first month and escalating monthly thereafter. Marci goes above and beyond to work with homeowners to make it easy. Please respect her time and the time of all the committee's work. They work for the betterment of the community.
