


# COMMUNITY






















# RECIPE OF THE MONTH

# Valentine Chocolate Souffle with Mocha Sauce



#### **Ingredients**

#### **Souffle:**

2 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted

3 teaspoons unsweetened cocoapowder, divided

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour

1/4 cup superfine sugar

½ teaspoon fine salt

1/4 teaspoon cornstarch

1 large egg

1 egg yolk

3 tablespoons heavy cream

2 tablespoons whole milk

2 (1 ounce) squares bittersweetchocolate, chopped

2 (1 ounce) squares semisweetchocolate, chopped 3 egg whites

1 teaspoon superfine sugar

#### **Mocha Sauce:**

- ½ cup heavy cream
- 2 (1 ounce) squares semisweet chocolate, chopped
- 1 tablespoon instant espresso powder
- 2 tablespoons light corn syrup
- 1 tablespoon coffee liqueur (such as Kahlua®)
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract

#### **Garnishes:**

2 small scoops vanilla ice cream



Prep: 30 mins Cook: 35 mins Additional: 25 mins Total: 1 hr 30 mins

**Servings:** 4

**Yield:** 2 8-ounce souffles

#### **Directions**

**Step 1**. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

**Step 2**. Brush the insides of two 8-ounce ramekins with melted butter. Chillfor 5 minutes, then brush again with melted butter. Add 1 teaspoon cocoa powder to each ramekin and roll around to evenly coat bottomand sides.

**Step 3**. Mix flour, 1/4 cup sugar, salt, and cornstarch in a small bowl. Beat eggand egg yolk together in a small bowl. Add to the flour mixture andwhisk until a smooth paste forms.

**Step 4**. Bring cream and milk to a simmer in a small saucepan. Remove fromheat; add bittersweet and semisweet chocolate and remaining cocoapowder. Stir until melted and fully combined. Gradually stir the hotchocolate into the flour-egg mixture.

**Step 5**. Return mixture to the pot and cook on medium-low until thick andsmooth, about 5 minutes. Let cool to room temperature, about 20minutes.

**Step 6**. Whisk egg whites into softpeaks using an electric mixer. Slowly add 1teaspoon sugar and keep whisking until stiffpeaks form.

**Step 7**. Carefully fold 1/3 of the chocolate mixture into the egg whites untilmostly combined. Repeat with the remaining chocolate mixture.





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
