Good day to all in Quail Meadows West,

I know it is only July but I want to reach out to anyone willing to be part of the HOA Board. We are always looking for homeowners willing to be part of the Board. This small group of 5 and the Architectural Committee (7) do everything we can to keep the monthly dues low and satisfy the needs of the community as much as possible.

If you wish to nominate someone for the Board of Directors please reach out to us. The rest of the year goes very quickly and we all get busy.

We have completed our Reserve Analysis which we will share with you soon. The streets are being slurry coated. Phase 2 starts July 31st and phase 3 starts August 7th. This should last 5 years till the streets need it again. DG in park is ongoing. Pool equipment has been repaired. We are working on the pool cover which takes weeks to get service. Should only be 2-3 weeks away.

Want to thank everyone who stopped parking in the guest parking. That issue is one of those areas that cause aggravation. Architectural Committee is doing an outstanding job keeping our community (homes and yards) looking great. We still have a couple of homes having issues but time and patience will ultimately prevail.

From our current Rules and Regulation:

- Every Home situated in the Quail Meadows West development shall be maintained in good order and repair by the owner or the resident thereof. The unit must be maintained at the sole expense of the owner or resident and their home kept in a clean, attractive and well-kept condition.
- All landscaping to include trees, bushes and other vegetation shall be kept as to not cause damage to other properties or common areas. If water regulations require a reduction in use, owners will adopt a more drought tolerant landscape design and make changes that continue to provide an attractive appearance. All yards must be maintained regardless of water use or design.
- All homeowners will maintain roofs, siding, walkways, driveways, paint and any other exterior portion of homes.
- All external repairs, maintenance or landscaping shall have architectural committee approval.



Phase 1; Tuesday, 7/11/23 Blue Phase 2; Monday, 7/31/23 Green Phase 3; Monday 8/7/23 Red

- Streets would close at 8am on the date scheduled and open the following day.
- All residents would not be allowed on the streets including Postal service, landscapers, delivery, school bus, etc. This will be a 24+ hour closure.
- All homeowners will need to remove their vehicles off the streets and out of guest parking areas. Guest parking and street parking will be allowed outside the specific area being coated.
- Please notify any and all service providers of the closure, ie Senior care, gardeners, postal service etc.
